Re: ES V "Real Time" Clock Losing or Gaining Time

For some time now it has been noticed that the "Real Time" Clock on the ES V jukebox's control unit is not always functioning correctly. The recognition of this problem has prompted our engineers to investigate this situation further.

The result of our engineers' testing is that the timer-chip IC5 (mk48T18) may pick up spurious noise through Pin 1 (N/C) and this somehow "fast-forwards" the "Real Time" Clock.

This problem is corrected in the following way:

Solder in a 10K pull-up resistor between IC5 pin 1 and IC5 pin 28.







New Warranty Policy

In an effort to clarify our service policy regarding warranty repairs, NSM America is adopting a new policy, effective October 15th, 1995. This policy states that the major components of an NSM jukebox will be repaired under warranty up to 15 months from the jukebox's date of sale from NSM America. This new policy will give our distributors a sufficient period of time (approximately 3 months) to sell the jukebox out of their inventory and still provide their customers with a 12 month warranty. It will also give NSM America and our distributors a clearly defined system of determining warranty status, since NSM America maintains a database of all jukebox sales over the past several years.

For this program to be effective, certain information must be included when shipping a component to NSM America for repair. In particular, the serial # of the jukebox from which the component is removed is necessary in determining the warranty/contract status of the repair. In most cases, this will not be difficult, since the major components of the jukebox (beginning with ES V technology) have been labeled with the serial # of the jukebox in which they were installed. These major components include:

CD Changer

* CCU

* Centrale

* Title Drum

* Bill Acceptor

* Transformer

Amplifier (ES V technology)

In order to better process the receipt of repair components at NSM America, we've included in a packet we've mailed to you today an updated Return Material Form for your use. It is important that all information be included on this form each time a component is shipped to NSM America. Please make several copies of this form and keep them on-hand for your use.

All of our efforts are focused on continuing to provide our distributors with the highest level of service possible, and to make NSM America the most solidly serviced product in our industry. If you have any questions regarding any of these issues, please feel free to contact our Service Manager, Tony Lantz.



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Microphone Adapter Board Installation

The introduction of ES 5.1 in NSM's wall mount jukeboxes Digital Thunder Wall, Performer Wall 2000, and Emerald ice jukeboxes marks the first incorporation of our 250 Watt RMS Amplifier/Centrale in our wall units. In redesigning our amplifier/centrale, the RCA input/output plugs and microphone plug were not incorporated into this unit. A special kit (# 177-488) is now available that includes a board and mounting pieces to adapt the amplifier/centrale for these functions. This kit can be used to modify our amplifier/centrale in NSM floor and wall units,

To install the Mic-Adapter board in a floor model:

- 1) Power off the phonograph and disconnect the power cord.
- 2) Open the lid frame and remove the closing plate, located on the right side of the back wall of the cabinet. Install the Mic-Adapter board on the support plate at the right side on the amplifier/centrale unit and mount it to the closing plate using the screws on the closing plate.
- 3) Phig in the free end of the connection cable into ST9 on the amplifier/centrale unit.

To install the Mic-Adapter board in a wall model:

- 1) Power off the phonograph and disconnect the power cord.
- 2) Open the front door and move the title drum to expose the amplifier/centrale unit. Install the white plastic standoff pieces on the rear wall of the jukebox, below the lower right of the amplifier/centrale unit. The Mic-Adapter board should be mounted on these pieces with microphone plug on the upper left. This will allow the connection cable to reach the ST9 position on the amplifier/centrale unit.
- 3) Plug in the free end of the connection cable into ST9 on the amplifier/centrale unit.
- 4) Feed all cables plugged into this board through the hole in the back wall of the jukebox.

While there is not a great dea! of space in the wall unit, the correct placement of this board will allow for adequate access to this board and its plugs.



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Microphone Adapter Board

The introduction of NSM's ES 5.1 technology in its wall mount jukeboxes *Digital Thunder Wall*, *Performer Wall 2000*, and *Emerald Ice* jukeboxes marks the first incorporation of our 250 Watt RMS Amplifier/Centrale in our wall units. This Amplifier/Centrale was first used in NSM's *Solid* Gold jukebox, and has been used in all subsequent NSM floor models. In redesigning our Amplifier/Centrale, the RCA input/output plugs and microphone plug were not incorporated into this unit. A special kit (# 177-488) is now available to adapt the Amplifier/Centrale for these functions. This kit includes the following:

- * (1) Microphone Adapter Board with 12-pin cable harness, microphone plug, and RCA input/output plugs.
- * (1) Frame mounting piece
- * (4) White plastic standoffs

In the installation of this board in NSM floor models, the frame mounting piece is used to affix the mic-adapter board on the right side of the back wall of the cabinet. The 12-pin cable harness is then plugged into position ST9 on the Amplifier/Centrale.

In the installation of the mic-adapter board in NSM wall models, install the white plastic standoff pieces on the rear wall of the jukebox, below the lower right of the Amplifier/Centrale unit. The Mic-Adapter board should be mounted on these pieces with microphone plug on the upper left. This will allow the 12-pin cable harness to reach the ST9 position on the Amplifier/Centrale unit. While there is not a great deal of space in the wall unit, the correct placement of this board will allow for adequate access to this board and its plugs.

The distributor cost on our Microphone-Adapter board is \$ 49.95. Through October 31st, however, we will offer this item at the **special price of \$ 41.95!**







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New Title Drum Service Policy

In May 1994, NSM marked the introduction of the *Solid Gold* with the implementation of a new service policy regarding our title drum. From May 1994 onward, NSM America has instituted a three year warranty on our title drum. This unprecedented policy represents NSM's strong commitment to support and service its products. In the 18 months since the policy's implementation, NSM has (unofficially) honored this three year warranty policy on all title drums it has ever produced. This generous policy has led to our service department being swamped with "defective" title drums being sent in for free exchange. We have found that many of these title drums - generally newer title drums - have had only minor defects (i.e. chipped pages, a bad opto coupler, etc.). These title drums, along with the large volume of older title drums we have received, have overburdened our service department to the point where we can not service our distributor network in a timely fashion.

Due to this situation, it is necessary for NSM to revise its policy regarding defective title drums. Effective November 6th, the following policy will be enacted regarding the NSM title drum:

- * All defective title drums with a serial number of 30,000 or greater will be exchanged at no charge.
- * Defective title drums with a serial number between 13,001 and 29,999 will be exchanged for a fee of \$ 125.00 **Or** NSM America will provide the spare parts Qty. 1 #176-832 Page Set, Qty. 4 # 174-751 Upper Worm Gear, and Qty. 4 # 174-764 Lower Worm Gear for a fee of \$ 25.00. In this situation, as an NSM distributor you would provide the labor to rebuild the defective title drum. In order to qualify to receive these parts, you **must** provide the NSM America Parts Department with the serial number of the defective title drum for which these parts will be used.
- * For defective title drums with a serial number between 0 and 13,000, an exchange charge of \$ 250.00 will be assessed. Due to major changes in the design of the title drum, it is not possible to appropriately update these title drums with new pages and worm gears.

We'll be forwarding a new fax form, including a part # of the kit, for your use in ordering these update kits. It is necessary to use this form and provide the serial # of the defective title drum when ordering replacement page & worm gear sets.

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Return Material Information

In Volume 2 of our *Service Notes*, NSM America revised its warranty policy to 15 months from the jukebox's date of shipment from NSM America. At that time, we also forwarded a new **Return Material Form**. We are happy to note that most distributors are using this new form (if you did not receive a copy of this specialized form, please contact the NSM Service Department for a form). The continued use of this form is very helpful in our processing of your service repairs.

There are a few areas which we need more information. In particular, please make sure to include the **jukebox model** and the **serial** # of the jukebox from which the defective component was removed. This information is very important in determining both the warranty status of the defective component but also allows us to track and maintain accurate service records on our jukebox models. Please make it a procedure to obtain this information when your department receives defective components for repair.

Advance Replacements

In addition to improving our processing of repairs, we are also asking that you help us in our efforts to "speed up" the return of advance replacement components. Over the past few months, your office has been notified of all advance replacement returns owed to NSM America. In many cases, such notification has improved the turnaround of these components. It has also pointed out a few instances where we have failed to properly note an item's return. We are continuing to work to improve our efficiencies, and we are asking for your continued support in returning your defective advance replacement components as quickly as possible. By improving on this procedure, NSM America will be able to provide a higher level of service to our distributors and their operators.



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Technical Tips!

Each and every week, our service department receives a number of calls from both distributors and operators who experience different technical problems with NSM jukeboxes. Here are a couple of the most recently encountered problems, from the service bench of Assistant Service Manager Mike Reith.


* We have received several calls from operators who have encountered problems with their wireless transmitters. Extensive troubleshooting failed to reveal the source of the problem. After talking with several different distributors and operators, it was determined that the new, red neon signs from *Red Dog* and *Red Wolf* beers were emitting an infrared frequency in the band which interfered with the functioning of the wireless infrared transmitter/receiver.

There are two rather straightforward solutions to this problem. First, this neon sign could simply be removed from the room in which the jukebox (or its transmitter/receiver) is located. (For the record, NSM America will not take these signs in for credit!!!) Second, if the location prefers to keep the sign, a hardwired remote (either pt.# 171-743 Full-featured or pt.# 170-212 3 Button) can be installed. These wired remote volume controls will **not** be affected by any infrared-frequency-emitting beer signs.

* In the past year, NSM changed the mechanical coin mechanism's drop configuration. This change causes the coin to drop into a different opto, therefore changing the coin channel that is used in the programming. This can cause the pricing to deviate from that which is programmed into the jukebox. Thus, it is important that, when installing a coin mechanism in a jukebox (used or new), please test the coin mechanism by dropping several coins through to determine whether the pricing is correct according to the operator's preference.

If the coin mechanism is not properly configured to the jukebox, go into the service program (#50 in ES IV and #70 in ES V /5.1) and adjust the coin channel program accordingly. If you have any problems with this procedure, please consult our Service Manual or contact the NSM Service Department for assistance.



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
Decoder Board Special!!!

The introduction of NSM's MBC III CD changer marked a major technical change from its predecessors - the incorporation of the decoder board into the CDM12 Laser Assembly. 

Title Drum Exchange Policy - Modifications & Clarifications!

In Volume 4 of our Service Notes, NSM America instituted a new policy regarding defective title drums. In particular, NSM America established a replacement parts kit that would be made available to our distributors to upgrade defective title drums between serial #'s 13,001 and 29,999. In particular, the policy stated:

Defective title drums with a serial number between 13,001 and 29,999 will be exchanged for a fee of \$ 125.00 **Or** NSM America will provide the spare parts - Qty. 1 #176-832 Page Set, Qty. 4 # 174-751 Upper Worm Gear, and Qty. 4 # 174-764 Lower Worm Gear for a fee of \$ 25.00. In this situation, as an NSM distributor you would provide the labor to rebuild the defective title drum. In order to qualify to receive these parts, you must provide the NSM America Parts Department with the serial number of the defective title drum for which these parts will be used.

This policy has been well-received, and few distributors have encoutered any problems in using our order form for the spare parts kits. After reviewing the contents of our spare parts kit, we have decided to alter the contents of this kit without increasing the cost. Effective December 18th, the following parts will be included in the spare parts kit: - Qty. 1 #176-832 Page Set, Oty. 4 # 174-751 Lower Worm Gear, Oty. 1 # 174-846 Front Gripper Pin, and Oty. 1 #175-952 Rear Gripper Pin. After reviewing our service records of defective title drums, we felt that it was not necessary to replace the upper worm gears in those title drums between 13,001 and 29,999. In most cases, these worm gears should already be black, so replacement should not be necessary. If, however, these worm gears are white, please indicate this on your form when placing the order, and we will include (4) 174-764 Upper Worm Gears in your shipment. To accommodate this larger bill acceptor, all ES 5.1 title displays have their circuit board (part # 178-533) mounted on the back of the title display. As a result of this modification, the circuit board has also been modified. Please note the following regarding this change:

In ES V title displays, the circuit board (part # 177-573) is mounted on the right hand side of the title display unit. As the diagram below notes, the circuit board has two red pushbuttons mounted on the board to allow for forward and reverse movement of the title pages.



The title display (part # 176-730) used in ES V jukeboxes -- with the circuit board mounted on the side -- can not be used in ES 5.1 jukeboxes! It can be used in all ES IV and ES V jukeboxes.



Jukebox Licensing

It's that time of year again, time for your operators to renew their jukebox licenses. According to the Jukebox License Office, all renewal filings should be submitted by March 15th (although the processing allows your operators to be a few days late). It is very important that operators comply with this organization for all jukeboxes placed in the market for public performance.

For each new jukebox an operator purchases, the operator must fill out the application form enclosed in the jukebox. After forwarding the completed application to the Jukebox License Office, the operator will receive a license certificate after four to six weeks. This certificate (a picture of which is included below) should be placed in the plastic insert included with the application form. This insert will preserve the certificate and keep it from becoming unreadable. The certificate should be placed in a highly



visible location of the jukebox. Most operators choose to place the certificate within the title drum area, which is both lighted and highly visible. With the certificate placed in the proper location, operators can avoid any unnecessary fines.

CDM12 Laser Assembly

Over the past few months, many of our distributors and operators have experienced intermittent "skipping" problems with the CDM12 laser player to our MBC III changer. We have corrected this problem with the installation of a new E-Prom on the player. All CDM12 lasers installed in our jukeboxes now use this latest version E-Prom, as well as all repairs/advance replacements shipped from NSM America.

While this modification has corrected this problem, it is important to note that, when installing this new, modified laser in the jukebox, please make certain that the jukebox's CCU has the latest (Version # 0004) E-Prom installed. Failure to install this E-Prom may result in the continuation of this iskipping problem, despite the fact that the jukebox is using the modified CDM12 laser.

Your service department has been sent copies of this latest CCU E-Prom (Version # 0004) for you to "burn in" and distribute to your operator customers. If you need additional copies of this E-Prom, please contact our service department at (630) 860-5100. By working together and "covering all the bases", we can minimize the inconvenience this problem has caused

Title Drum Assembly

The new year has brought about a few changes in our policies/pricing regarding title drum exchanges and repairs. Detailed in our December 31st Service Notes, our warranty policy will cover all title drums installed in Jukeboxes manufactured from January 1, 1994 or later; an exchange fee of \$ 295.00 will be charged for those title drums manufactured before January 1, 1994. In addition, our title drum update kit (part # 17X-832) — which consists of (1) title page set, (4) lower worm gears, (1) trent gripper, and (1) rear gripper — is available for purchase from NSM America for \$ 95.00

One important piece of information was omitted from the recent Service Notes. The title drum serial number is the indicator by which it is determined whether or not the unit is under warranty. For all title drums with a serial # of 38,000 or higher, the unit is under warranty, and each unit will be repaired & returned to you (ki order to keep track of the warranty). For all title drums with a serial # 37,999 or lower, a fee of \$ 295.00 will be charged for exchange of a defective unit. Please note that these units will carry a one-year warranty from date of shipment from NSM America. This information should clear up any uncertainties you may have

At this time, we are experiencing a three week back order on the repairlexchange of title drums in our service department. In addition, we are currently backgrdered on title page sets (a situation we expect will be remedied within 7 to 10 days). We are working to improve our turnaround and minimize backgrders, and will keep you informed as new information is available.



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Title Drum Assembly Repair/Replacement

We highlighted in our last *Parts Notes* the changes in our policies/pricing regarding title drum exchanges and repairs. We would like to note, once again, our title drum repair/replacement policies which are now in effect:



- For defective title drums installed in jukeboxes manufactured from January
 1, 1994 or later, the title drum will be replaced at no charge. These units are designated with a serial number of 38,000 or higher.
- For defective title drums installed in jukeboxes manufactured prior to January 1, 1994, the title drum will be exchanged for a fee of \$ 295.00. These units are designated with a serial number of 37,999 or less. All units repaired and/or replaced by NSM America will carry a one-year warranty from date of shipment from NSM America.
- In addition, our title drum update kit (part # 17X-832) -- which consists of (1) title page set, (4) lower worm gears, (1) front gripper, and (1) rear gripper is available for purchase from NSM America for \$ 95.00.

At this time, we are working to erase a two-to-three week back order on the repair/exchange of title drums in our service department. We have filled our previous backorders on title page sets, and now have quantities in stock. We will continue to work to minimize this backorder situation.

CDM12 Laser Assembly Update

Over the past few months, some of our distributors and operators have experienced "blanking out" or intermittent "skipping" problems with the CDM12 laser player in our MBC III changer. This is a problem which you may have encountered, in that you may have received additional requests for advance replacement CDM12 laser players.

We have corrected these "blanking out" and intermittent "skipping" problems with the installation of a new servo board on the laser player. All CDM12 lasers installed in our jukeboxes now incorporate this latest version CDM12 laser player, as well as all repairs/advance replacements shipped from NSM America.

It is important that several steps are followed by your customers when troubleshooting these laser player problems. After installing the latest version CDM12 laser player (Version # 1.2)n the changer, there are two further checks that must be done:

- Please make certain that the latest version E-Prom (Version #0105) is installed on the MBC III CD changer's control board.
- Please make certain that the latest version E-Prom (Version # 0104) is installed on jukebox's CCU.

Our recent experience indicates that the failure to install each of these updates may result in the continuation of the "blanking out" or and/or "skipping" problem, <u>despite</u> the fact that the jukebox is using the modified CDM12 laser player. Please make certain to follow these guidelines when working with your operator customers who are experiencing these problems.

Your service department has been sent copies of the latest CCU E-Prom (Version # 0104) and MBC III CD changer E-Prom (Version # 0105) for you to "burn in" and distribute to your operator customers. If you need an additional copy of either E-Prom, please contact our service department at (630) 860-5100. By working together and "covering all the bases", we can minimize the inconvenience this problem has caused.

New Mars Wall-Mount Conversion Kit

Since the introduction of the Mars bill acceptor into our ES 5.1 wall and floor jukeboxes, NSM has received a number of inquires regarding installation of the Mars S-2000 bill acceptor into older NSM jukebox models. With the number of different designs and spacing within our different jukebox models, we have undergone considerable research regarding such an upgrade. At this time, we would like to address the issue of upgrading our wall model jukeboxes.

NSM manufactured the following wall models with the following bill acceptors over the past seven years:



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Updated Policy For Dixie Narco DBA3 Bill Acceptors

With the Mars S-2000 bill acceptors installed in NSM wall and floor jukeboxes for the last eighteen months, the warranty period for most of the Dixie Narco DBA3 validator is ending. The DBA3 was installed in later-version ES V jukeboxes as well as earlier version ES 5.1 jukeboxes. In particular, NSM manufactured the following wall models with the following bill acceptors over the past seven years:

As noted above, the warranty period on most DBA3 units is now ending. For defective units shipped to NSM America for repair, a fee of \$ 70.00 will be charged, and the unit will be exchanged. Units repaired by Dixie Narco and exchanged by NSM America carry a three-month warranty period (and are denoted by a /R at the end of the serial number). To determine the manufacturing date of the unit – and its contract/warranty status, please note the following:

- The first three number of the serial number (located on the label) indicates the month and year of manufacturing. (For instance, serial #06501114 was manufactured in June, 1995.) It is this manufacturing that is used to determine the warranty/contract status.
- Any serial number with a /R at the end of the number has already been repaired by Dixie Narco. These units only carry a three-month warranty.

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CDM12 Repair Kit

Over the last several months (mid-May 1997), NSM America's service department has implemented a comprehensive repair procedure for the CDM12 Laser Assembly. procedure, which includes sanding, lubrication, and the installation of a metal bar over the laser's existing laser guide, has proven quite effective in minimizing the CDM12's "skipping" problem.

While the introduction of version AH03 has diminished the skipping problems considerably, skipping problems still occur in this version as well as earlier versions. The problem involves laser's rails, on which the laser's "sled" moves back and forth when playing the CD. When the rails are not entirely smooth, the laser can skip as the "sled" runs over bumps. Our repair procedure involves smoothing the rail's surface and inserting a metal bar over the existing rails. These steps ensure that the "sled" moves back and forth on a smooth surface. In addition to smoothing, proper lubrication must also be done.

To provide our distributors with the tools necessary to do the job correctly. NSM America is now offering a CDM12 Repair Kit. The kit includes the following:

Please note that the kit (part #) includes complete instructions for the steps that should be followed in completing a CDM12 laser modification/repair. The cost of the kit is \$8.95, and the grease included should allow for the repair of up to 200 CDM12 lasers.

The success of this solution is largely due to the way in which the repair is handled. In particular, improper sanding of the top of the laser guide and/or incorrect lubrication can cause more damage. Thus, before beginning to repair CDM12 lasers, we strongly urge you to contact our Training Manager, Keith White, to schedule a time when you can visit and receive proper training. As a distributor, we will not sell these kits to you until after you receive this training.





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Title Drum Repair Policy

As NSM America continues to maintain its three-year warranty policy on our title drum assembly, we like to update you periodically concerning those units that are presently covered under this policy.

Each title drum has a 5-digit serial attached to the right side of the assembly. Effective May 1, 1998, all units with a serial number of 52,000 or less are no longer covered under this three-year warranty. The serial number 52,000 corresponds to the last unit produced by NSM in January 1995. We are extending this warranty an additional three months to accommodate for a period of shipping and warehousing of these jukeboxes before delivery to your operator customers. Those units "out of warranty" will be updated for a distributor cost of \$ 295.00.

Our three-year warranty policy has been in effect since June 1995, and we believe that it is a policy that is fair to NSM distributors. Given the fact that we have established this policy to minimize the expense to NSM operators (and therefore increase sales over time), we would appreciate that this exchange fee or warranty exchange be passed along with minimal additional charges. In particular, those units exchanged under warranty should only have a small handling fee charged to your operator customers.

In addition to this repair policy, NSM America also offers a title drum "update kit" (#17X-832) that allows distributors and/or operators to update their title drum assemblies themselves. The kit consists of the following items:

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CDM12 Repair Policy

We are now beginning to ship our first CD Pro units (part#179-195) installed in our **Sapphire** floor jukeboxes. The CD Pro unit is interchangeable with the CDM12 unit and will replace the CDM12 in the near future. NSM America will continue to service the CDM12 laser units; the following is a review and update of our repair policy regarding CDM12 laser units.

CDM12 laser units were first installed in NSM jukeboxes in July 1995, beginning in floor models *Digital Thunder*, *Performer Grand 2000*, and *Nostalgia Gold* as well as wall models *Digital Thunder Wall*, *Performer Wall*, and *Emerald Ice*. Since this time, NSM America has updated, repaired, and exchanged these units under warranty. The update and repair of the CDM12 includes the installation of a metal bar on the laser's rail, which creates a smooth surface for the laser's sled and eliminates the CDM12's skipping problem. This solution has been working without failure since May 1997.

As we are now integrating the CD Pro in our jukeboxes and as a replacement part, we are adjusting our warranty policy concerning the CDM12 laser player. Since many CDM12 lasers have been out for a long period of time and there is a limited life to the diode, we will now be assessing whether the laser assembly is within the warranty period. For an "out of warranty" CDM12 unit sent to NSM for repair, the following policy will apply:

- If the laser's diode is found to be "dead", the laser will be exchanged for a distributor cost of \$ 195.00.
- If the laser's diode is still functional and the problems encountered with the unit concern rough rail surfaces, a modification of the laser's rails will be performed at no charge.

At this time, we will continue to honor our policy of upgrading the CDM12 laser assembly's rails under warranty. If, however, the CDM12 laser is out of warranty and the laser's diode fails, NSM will not cover this failure under warranty. The laser's diode has performed as expected, so we do not feel obligated to cover failure of this component beyond our normal warranty period.

We hope that this policy is clear. If there are any problems or questions, please feel free to contact the NSM America Service Department.



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Repair/Exchange Policy

We would like to take this opportunity to update you regarding our repair and service policies for our NSM distributors:

Warranty Period: NSM America extends a warranty of 15 months (from date

of shipment from NSM America) for all major components (i.e. CD changer, laser assembly, centrale/amplifier unit, CCU, and bill acceptor) of the jukebox. Our internal database monitors and confirms the warranty status of the components based on the ship date of the component's

serial number.

Labor Rate: For all repairs (both CD and vinyl) out-of-warranty, our

labor rate is \$ 70.00/hour.

DBA3 Bill Acceptor: For those units out of warranty, a \$ 70.00 exchange fee is

charged for an upgraded unit.

CDM12 Laser Assembly: For all units found to be unrepairable (i.e. the laser's diode

is "dead") and out of warranty (see above), a new laser

assembly is sold for a cost of \$ 195.00.

CDM4/53 Laser Assembly: For all units found to be unrepairable (i.e. the laser's diode

is "dead"), a new laser assembly is sold for a cost of

\$ 195.00.

CDM4/36 Laser Assembly: For all units found to be unrepairable (i.e. the laser's diode



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New Exchange Policy for CDM 12 Laser Assembly

A program involving the exchange of a CD-Pro unit for a CDM12 unit is now being offered by NSM. With the implementation of this policy (effective August 1st), it is necessary to clarify our spare parts and service/exchange policies.

CD-Pro Pricing

The purchase price for a CD-Pro unit will be \$ 250.00. Our suggested retail price to NSM operators is \$ 360.00.

CD-Pro Exchange Policy


For NSM jukebox operators wishing to upgrade an existing CDM12 unit that is within specification (it must have a functioning laser diode) to a CD-Pro unit, a CD-Pro may be purchased by an NSM distributor for \$ 250.00 and re-sold to the jukebox operator for \$ 360.00 (suggested operator price). Upon return of the CDM12 unit within specification to NSM America, a credit of \$ 125.00 will be issued to the distributor. We suggest that a credit of \$ 195.00 should then be issued to the jukebox operator, giving him/her a net exchange price of \$ 165.00.

CDM12 Advance Replacement Policy

- When requesting an advance replacement for a CDM12 unit, NSM distributors and operators can expect to receive an upgraded CDM12 unit. If there are no CDM12 units available for advance replacement, the defective CDM12 unit should be sent in for repair.
- If a CD-Pro unit is specifically requested as an advance replacement for a CDM12 unit, it will fall under the NSM CD-Pro exchange policy.

CDM12 Repair Policy

- Our repair policy on the CDM12 unit will remain the same. We will continue to offer our CDM12 modification (i.e. smoothing of the laser's rail and insertion of a metal bar) at no charge, and have continuing evidence that this is an effective solution to the ongoing "skipping" problems that have occurred in CDM12 lasers in the past.
- Another option is that a CDM12 unit sent to NSM America for repair that can be restored to its operating specification can be exchanged for a new CD-Pro unit under the CD-Pro policy stated above.



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

CDM12 Warranty Policy

 A CDM12 unit sent to NSM America for repair or replacement and found to be out of specification will be exchanged for a replacement laser assembly at no charge under our existing warranty policy. If the CDM12 unit is no longer under warranty, a new CD-Pro unit will be exchanged for \$ 250.00 distributor cost, with a suggested retail price to NSM operators of \$ 360.00.

The introduction of this exchange program is intended to address those NSM operators who wish to "upgrade" to CD-Pro lasers at an affordable cost. Given the extensive nature of this program, please take a moment to review it with your sales, service, and parts staff to determine the level of exposure you wish to give this program.



These "filler kits" are being forwarded at no charge for each Sapphire jukebox already shipped, and will be included with each Sapphire jukebox shipped from NSM beginning August 1st.





Dear John,

Since the recent introduction of the GEMFIRE, we've received input that a modification was required to increase the security of the door assembly. As a result, we're forwarding this week a lock modification kit for the GEMFIRE.

The kit includes two different items (and the necessary screws to attach them) that, when properly installed, will further reduce the possibility of the front door assembly being opened without a key. We have received input that, by pushing upward on the door assembly, it might be possible to open the door without a key. The kit's contents include:

- (1) Closing lever ("A" on the attached diagram) that should be installed on the bottom inside corner of the GEMFIRE'S door. This closing lever is attached to the inside corner of the jukebox door, and will prevent a locked jukebox from being improperly opened by exerting upward force on the door assembly.
- (1) Metal plate ("B" on the attached diagram) that should be installed to prevent the locking lever from slipping off the locking bar.


Please note that, on the attached diagram, the correct sized screws are noted. The installation of these items should only take a few minutes.

As you continue to purchase and sell our new **GEMFIRE** jukebox, we're forwarding to you at this time materials for those units you have already received.

This shipment contains a packet of materials for each **GEMFIRE** jukebox (serial #'s 1578, 1616, 1624, 1629, 1642, 1714, 1719, 1758, 1779, 1781) that CAGS has purchased. Each packet contains:


- A GEMFIRE service manual, which has technical and spare parts information for the new jukebox. The
 manual was not ready at the time these units were shipped, so we are forwarding them at this time.
- A GEMFIRE CD Jacket Filler Card kit, which includes (8) pairs of cards in the CD jacket and title card sizes. With (4) open spaces in the GEMFIRE'S title display, (located at the upper left and right of the first and last presentation of the title display), these (8) pairs are intended to "fill in" these open spaces and give the jukebox a more attractive appearance.
- A GEMFIRE lock modification kit, which includes (1) Closing lever, (1) Metal plate, and (3) screws. Detailed instructions are included in this kit, and we have faxed a copy of these instructions to your service manager for your reference. When properly installed, these items will further reduce the possibility of the front door assembly being opened without a key. After our first shipment of GEMFIRE units, we received input from a few operator customers that, by pushing upward on the door assembly, it might be possible to open the door without a key. While we did not view this problem as "catastrophic", our design engineers nonetheless felt it was appropriate to modify the design, implement these changes in production, and forward kits for those units that were shipped without these items. (Note: All units shipped from NSM America since Monday, November 30th had this lock modification kit installed in production. Thus, packets for those GEMFIRE units will not contain a lock modification kit.)

We have forwarded individual packets for each **GEMFIRE** unit that includes the above-listed materials. The items are organized by jukebox serial number, so it is only necessary to forward each packet to the appropriate customer or place it inside those jukeboxes still in your inventory. Please make certain that these materials are forwarded A.S.A.P. NSM America has worked hard to gather and forward these materials to you, so we would greatly appreciate your forwarding them quickly as well!



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Title Drum Repair Policy

ntinues to maintain its "
update vo" As NSM America continues to maintain its three-year warranty policy on our title drum assembly, we like to update you periodically concerning those units that are presently covered under this policy.

Each title drum has a 5-digit serial attached to the right side of the assembly. Effective April 1, 1999, all units with a serial number of 56,000 or less are no longer covered under this three-year warranty. The serial number 56,000 corresponds to the last unit produced by NSM in October 1995. We are extending this warranty an additional three months to accommodate for a period of shipping and warehousing of these jukeboxes before delivery to your operator customers. The distributor cost for a rebuild of an "out of warranty" unit will remain \$ 295.00.

It is not possible to rebuild title drum units with a serial number under 9,000. Title drum units shipped to NSM America with a serial number of 9,000 or less will not be repaired. Therefore, do not send these units to NSM America for repair. Instead, a new title drum unit should be purchased for a distributor cost of \$ 500.00.

Our three-year warranty policy has been in effect since June 1995, and we believe that it is a policy that is fair to NSM distributors. Given the fact that we have established this policy to minimize the expense to NSM operators (and therefore increase sales over time), we would appreciate that this exchange fee or warranty exchange be passed along without any or minimal charges. In particular, those units exchanged under warranty should only have a small handling fee charged to your operator customers.

In addition to this repair policy, NSM America also offers a title drum "update kit" (#17X-832) that allows distributors and/or operators to update their title drum assemblies themselves. The kit consists of the following items:

CDM12/CD-Pro Exchange Program

NSM America has seen a large number of music operators participating in our CDM12 to CD-Pro exchange program. The overwhelming demand has exceeded our supply, and we continue to work to correct this problem. We appreciate your continued patience!

Despite the fact that we have forwarded information several times regarding our policy, we continue to receive questions for NSM distributors and operators.

To clarify this matter, we've summarized our policy below:

- A CD-Pro may be purchased by an NSM distributor for \$ 250.00 and re-sold to the jukebox operator for \$ 360.00 (suggested operator price).
- Upon return of a complete CDM12 unit to NSM America, a credit of \$ 125.00 will be issued to the distributor, making it a net exchange price to the distributor of \$ 125.00.
- If a credit of \$ 195.00 is then issued to the jukebox operator, this would give them a competitive net exchange price of \$ 165.00. If you wish to be more than competitive, you can offer a larger credit to the operator.

Since this policy is an important sales and technical issue, please take the time to distribute this information to your parts and service staff as well as the NSM sales people within your organization. We strongly believe that our policy is fair and gives NSM operators a good value, so it is imperative that your staff fully understand the policy and properly communicate it to your operator customers.

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CDM12/CD-Pro Installation Tips

When installing a new CD-Pro (or re-built CDM12) unit into an ES 5.1 jukebox, it is important that you check the following:

- 1) The CD-Pro/CDM12 laser mounts its four "feet" on four posts that are attached to the "floor" of the CD changer. In most cases, the CD changer has a washer placed underneath each of the four "feet" to compensate for manufacturing tolerances of the posts. These washers may have been installed so that the laser is sitting at the appropriate position to receive the tray (and CD) to play music. When installing a new CD-Pro or CDM12 laser unit, please check if washers are inserted underneath the feet of the laser you are removing. If they are present, make certain that there are washers (# 690-020) under each of the four feet when the new laser is installed. Persistent "rubbing" of a CD on the tray during play may be due to no washers being inserted under the laser's feet. If this occurs, insert a washer under each of the laser's four "feet".
- 2) The E-Proms on the Control & Credit Unit and the CD changer's Controller Board must be updated to the latest version in order to make the updating of the laser effective. To check the version of these E-Prom's, please do the following:
- Pull out the jukebox's service switch and press the "C" button on the keypad until only a "P" is displayed on the left side.
- Press "3" and "H"; please note the four digit number displayed on the right hand side of the display. (It should read "0106"). This number represents the version E-Prom installed on the CCU. If it does not read "0106", a new version E-Prom should be installed.
- Press the "1" button; please note the four digit number displayed on the right hand side of the display. (It should read "0106") This number represents the version E-Prom installed on the CD changer's Controller Board. If it does not read "0106", a new version E-Prom should be installed.

If you need copies of the latest versions of the E-Prom's for the CCU (version # 0106) and CD changer's Controller Board (version # 0106), please contact our service department. We'll forward to you a copy of each to allow you to "burn in" additional copies for your operator customers.

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Title Drum Repair Policy

As NSM America continues to maintain its three-year warranty policy on our title drum assembly, we like to update you periodically concerning those units that are presently covered under this policy.

Effective January 1, 2000, all units with a serial number of 63,000 or less are no longer covered under this three-year warranty. The serial number 63,000 corresponds to the last unit produced by NSM in October 1996 (allowing an additional period for stocking and sale to the music operator). The distributor cost for a rebuild of an "out of warranty" unit will remain \$ 295.00. To minimize the expense to NSM operators (and therefore increase sales over time), we would appreciate that this exchange fee or warranty exchange be passed along without any or minimal charges. In particular, those units exchanged under warranty should only have a small handling fee charged to your operator customers.

Please remember that it is not possible to rebuild title drum units with a serial number under 9,000. Title drum units shipped to NSM America with a serial number of 9,000 or less will not be repaired. As a replacement, a new title drum unit should be purchased; the part numbers, descriptions, and distributor cost of each are listed below:
