

## WURLITZER SERVICE SLANTS

OUR QUESTIONS OR COMMENTS ON "SERVICE SLANTS" ARE WELCOME AT ANY TIME

SUBJECT: Wiring Change, Top Tunes Unit.

AFFECTING: Wurlitzer Statesman 3400 and 3460 Phonographs with Top Tunes manufactured prior to January 9, 1970.

COMPLAINT: Top Tune credit established by depositing one quarter.

CAUSE: Playrak Cancel Wheel overtravel bounces Top Tune switch.

CORRECTION MODEL 3400:

1. Remove Junction Box from floor of Phonograph.

- 2. Remove cover from Top Tune Unit, mounted on Junction Box.
- 3. Cut #19 wire (White Purple) at pin 15 of 30 pin plug.
- 4. Connect, solder and tape the #19 wire to the #28 wire (Gray-Red). The #28 wire connects pin 27 of the 30 pin plug to pin 1 of the 9 pin socket.

CORRECTION MODEL 3460:

- 1. Remove Junction Box from floor of Phonograph.
- 2. Remove cover from Top Tune Unit, mounted on Junction Box.
- 3. Cut #20 wire (Black-Purple) at pin 29 of 30 pin plug.
- 4. Connect, solder and tape the #20 wire to the #28 wire (Gray-Red). The #28 wire connects pin 27 of the 30 pin plug to pin 1 of the 9 pin socket.
