SUBJECT:

Connection of existing Wurlitzer Model 5134 Satellite Selective Console Speaker to Wurlitzer Model 3500, 200 Selection, Phonograph.

PROCEDURE:

To connect existing Wurlitzer Model 5134 Satellite Selective Console Speaker to Wurlitzer Model 3500, 200 Selection, Phonograph, equipped with a Wurlitzer Model 268 Stepper, perform the following:

- 1. Run Twelve Conductor Cable, Part No. 126390, from Satellite to Phonograph. Leave enough slack at each end of cable run to allow servicing of Satellite and Phonograph.
- 2. The cable should be concealed, if possible and kept dry. Fasten the cable every eighteen inches and at all corners.
- 3. Connect the cable from the Satellite Terminal Strips to WALL BOX Terminal Strip, located on Accessory Terminal Panel on the Phonograph, as follows:

Tape and stow both ends of Red Wire.

NOTE

The Pink, Tan and Brown Wires from Terminals 9, 10 and 11 are for Computer operation only. However, connecting these wires as outlined on Pg.1will in no way effect operation if Computer has not been installed in Phonograph.

4. Tighten all Terminal Lug screws securely.
