Wurlitzer Model C-110 Cassette

COMPLAINT:

Insufficient engagement of some Cassette Tapes on Tape Deck Turntable causing cancellation when Cassette Tape is placed in "Play" position.

CORRECTIVE ACTION:

Installation of a Retaining Ring (used as a spacer) to provide additional pressure on the Turntable Springs.

NOTE

This modification has been incorporated on some Model C-110 Cassette Tape Players recently shipped from the factory.

Material Required

4 - 0019030006 Retaining Ring

To correct the above complaint, perform the following:

- 1. Position one RETAINING RING, Part No. 0019030006, on each TURNTABLE as shown in Figure 1.
- 2. Lift SPRING sufficiently to provide clearance between TURNTABLE and SPRING, then install RETAINING RING on TURNTABLE SHAFT as shown in Figure 2.
- 3. Repeat Steps 1 and 2 for opposite Tape Deck.




