TONE ARM ADJUSTMENT FOR 45 R. P. M.

Due to the difference in operating radius of the upper and lower tone arms, adjustment of the "link and pin take-up" will be required. This adjustment is accessible at the extreme rear of the upper tone arm. It should be set to provide the same nominal feed-in position for both upper and lower tone arm.

Otherwise tone arm feed-in and feed-in stop adjustments are identical with adjustment procedures contained in the Service Manual, S-312, Section 6, Pages 11 and 15.
