SUBJECT: KIT 147 REMOTE VOLUME CONTROL UNIT MODIFICATION For Use With
Monophonic Phonograph Models 2500, 2510 and 2504

The following instructions are provided to enable the use of the major components of Kit 147 (now in a location) for a modified remote control unit that will operate properly on the above subject phonograph models.

It will be necessary to secure and replace certain resistors and condensers that are required for proper tone compensation. The electrical values of the resistors and condensers needed are shown in Figure 2. These parts may be obtained locally or purchased from our Parts Department.

Figure 1 represents the wiring of Kit 147 before modification. Figure 2 represents wiring of the modified Kit 147.

There are no changes necessary in the wiring of the relay box and plug assembly.

When ordering a new remote volume control unit from the factory to be used for the Model 2500 Series Monophonic Phonographs, it should be ordered as Kit 147A. This new kit is similar to the modified Kit 147.

The Kit 160-50 Remote Loudness Control will be continued for use with the Model 2500 Series Stereo Phonographs.

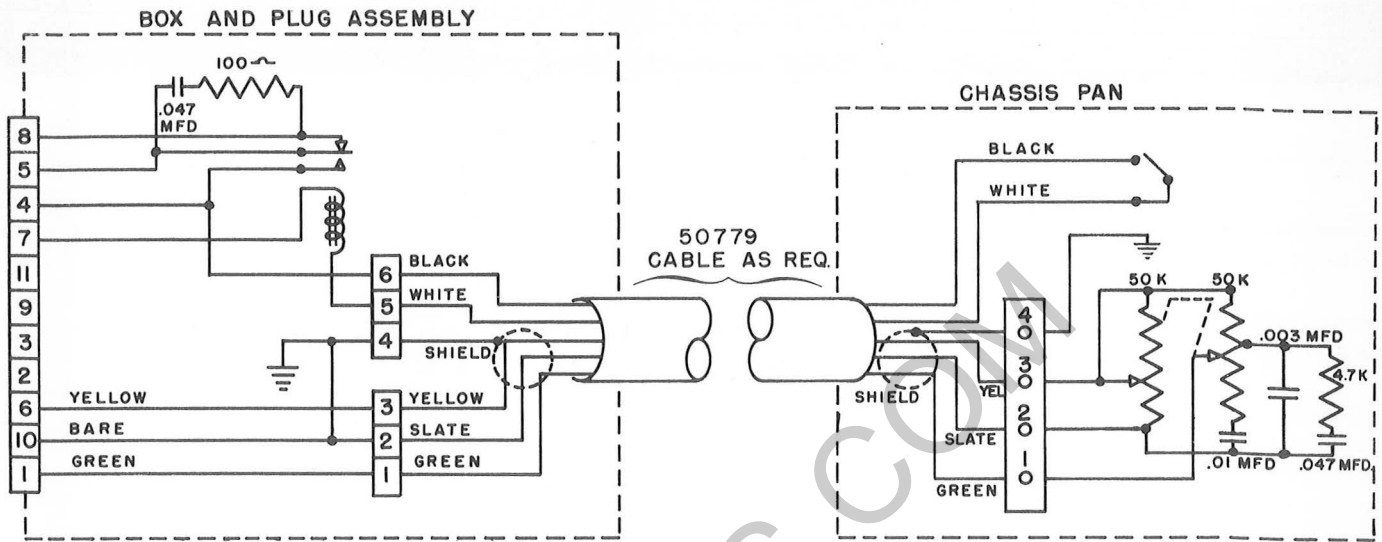

MODIFIED KIT-147

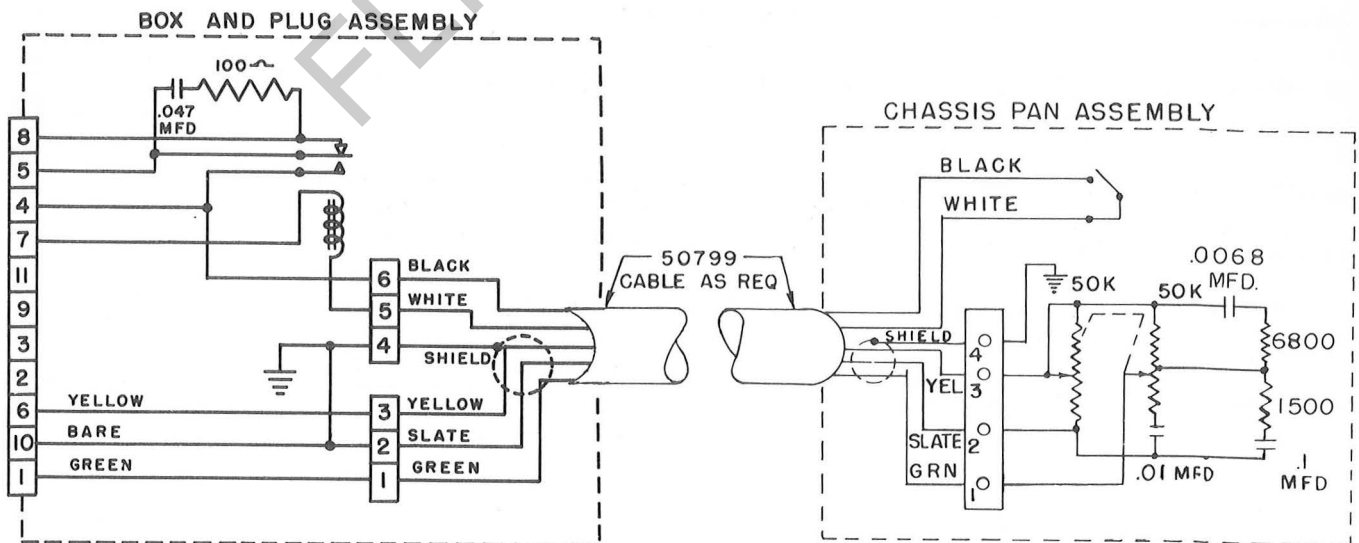
